Football Coach Application Form 2010

- 1) The coach(s) must represent the best in football and leadership. The coach(s) conduct is always under scrutiny. They must, at all times, be a role model for their players. Their actions affect their players, parents and fans. In line with this, the League requires the following standard of conduct from all of its coaches:
 - a) The coach will always keep the health and welfare of players foremost and will remove from a game or practice any injured player whose health is in doubt.
 - b) The coach will always strive to set an example for his players "on and off" the field.
 - c) The coach will not smoke on the practice field or on the sidelines during games.
 - d) The coach will not berate a player in front of teammates, parents or fans. The coach will not berate or criticize game officials and will accept their decisions as fair.
 - e) The coach will not run-up the score on a weaker opponent.
 - f) The coach will not insight fans or spectators into actions unbecoming the game *of* football.
 - g) The coach will refrain from the use of alcoholic beverages on the practice and game fields at all times.
 - h) The coach will reinforce the importance of scholastic as well as athletic achievements.
 - i) The coach will follow the parameters of the League's By-Laws and Policy and Procedures.
 - j) The coach will not use ineligible players and will bring to the attention of the league any information, which affects the eligibility of his or any other players.
 - k) The coach will make sure that all players are given an opportunity to play the required number of plays under league rules.
 - l) The coach will Follow TCYFL and Bartlett Hawks league rules and regulations at all times.

- 2) As a coach for the Bartlett Hawks, it is **REQUIRED** that you participate in the following:
 - a) Submit to and pass an Illinois State Police Felony Background Check.
 - b) Complete CPR/AED training
 - c) Complete a coach's certification course
 - d) Attend ALL coach's meetings.
 - e) Participate in Equipment Issuance and Collection, Field Set-up, Breakdown and Maintenance.

- 3) All coach's matters are subject to review by the Coach's Committee. Recommendations are then presented to the Board of Directors. Decisions of the Board of Directors are FINAL.

- 4) Failure of the coach to adhere to TCYFL. or Bartlett Hawks, league policies or procedures will result in disciplinary action by the Bartlett Hawks Board.

- 5) If you are a head coach, you will be issued a coach's bag, which includes items such as footballs, blocks, tees, etc. Upon receipt of this bag in June/July, you will be asked to give a security deposit in the form of a post-dated check of 12/01/2010. When the bag and all items are returned in good condition at the end of the season, you will receive back your security deposit check.

- 6) If you choose to not continue as a coach, all information about the our program and the players' contact data including but not limited to phone numbers, addresses and email addresses, is the proprietary property of the Bartlett Hawks Youth Football & Dance League. You should not use or disclose any confidential and proprietary information, which you acquired through your work with our program to any other person or entity, or use such information in a manner that is detrimental to the interest of the Bartlett Hawks Youth Football & Dance League. Furthermore, you should not retain any copies, electronic or otherwise of such property. Any loss or damages, from any action you take that is detrimental to The Bartlett Hawks Youth Football & Dance League will be turned over to our legal counsel.
